

Gaming Talking Points

June 2016

History

- Video and Riverboat Gaming was approved by the Louisiana Legislature in 1991
- LSP Gaming started issuing Riverboat and Video Poker licenses in 1992
- Louisiana authorized 15 Riverboat licenses, 1 Land-based license, and 4 Slots at Race Tracks licenses.
- There are 29 Parishes that have authorized Riverboat gaming and 31 parishes that have authorized Video Poker.

Casinos by Market

- Shreveport/Bossier – 6 Riverboat and 1 Slots at the Track
- Lake Charles – 3 Riverboats and 1 Slots at the Track – **Golden Nugget Opened December 2014 – Lake Charles market increased \$155.4M (22.7%) in FY 14/15 and \$41.1M (4.9%) for FY 15/16.**
- Lafayette – 1 Riverboat and 1 Slots at the Track
- Baton Rouge – 3 Riverboats
- New Orleans – 2 Riverboats, 1 Slots at the Track, and 1 Land-based Casino
